**WAIVER OF LIABILITY  
GENERAL RELEASE FOR MISSION TRIPS AND FIELD TRIPS**

**RECITALS**

A. \_\_\_\_\_ (The student) desires to participate in mission and trips and field trips with Waco First Assembly of God (WFA).

B. The student understands that certain risks and dangers that result from the student's participation in the mission trip or field trip are foreseeable, such as: illnesses without access to adequate medical facilities for treatment; political unrest that may result in injury, imprisonment or death; accidents that may occur with no advance notice; hostilities that may result in the student's being held hostage; or being stranded and not being able to return to WFA.

C. The student understands that this list of dangers is not comprehensive.

D. WFA has provided the student with all U.S. State Department warnings and pronouncements regarding the proposed destinations. The student has read and evaluated all materials regarding the proposed destinations.

E. The student understands that some dangers are beyond the control of WFA, but the student still wants to participate. The student recognizes that WFA's policies prohibit it from intervening on behalf of the student should any calamity arise. The student recognizes that WFA will not pay any amounts to remedy the student's situation, including the payment of ransom or bribes.

**AGREEMENT**

BE IT KNOWN that the student, for and in consideration of being allowed to participate in mission trips or field trips, and other valuable consideration received from WFA, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby remise, release, acquit, satisfy, and forever discharge WFA of and from all manner of actions, causes of action, suits, debts, covenants, contracts, controversies, agreements, promises, claims and demands whatsoever, which the student ever had, now has, or which any personal representative, successor, heir or assign of said the student, hereafter can, shall or may have, against WFA, by reason of any matter, cause or thing whatsoever, related in any way to the student's participation in mission trips or field trips sponsored by WFA. The student, by signing below, certifies that he or she fully understands that this release will provide an absolute defense to any lawsuit or claim against WFA for any injuries or damage that the student may incur by reason of the student's participation in the mission trip or field trip.

- The student agrees that he or she is solely responsible for evaluating whether the proposed destinations are within their risk tolerance. The student is undertaking this trip solely after independently evaluating all risks associated with the trip.
- The student further agrees to indemnify WFA from all liabilities arising in favor of third parties resulting from the student's conduct while on the mission trip or field trip.

- The student agrees to be responsible for any expenses that exceed WFA’s budget for the trip, including early return expenses or emergency evacuation expenses. The student is solely responsible for procuring any insurance that he or she deems appropriate.
- The student has had the opportunity to review this General Release with the attorney of their choice.

The student has received answers to all their questions. The student has read and understood this Agreement.

The student signs this General Release voluntarily free from all coercion.
